The Hotdish

If you live in Minnesota, chances are, you are quite familiar with the "Hotdish." Now, I'm not referring to the compliment of being a hot dish, but the stick-to-the-ribs kind of meal that is hot and bubbly.

There is a little controversy in our country as to what you call this complete meal in a dish. Some call this a casserole, some call it hotdish. One may even refer to it as goulash. We do know this all-in-one meal was created in the Midwest during the Great Depression to stretch their food into a fulfilling meal.

The first published recipe for this Midwest creation was in a 1930's cookbook. This cookbook was published by Grace Lutheran Church in Mankato, Minnesota, by Mrs. C. W. Anderson. We all know the joys of a good church cookbook. The recipes are tried and true by some excellent domestic engineers who know their way around the kitchen. The recipe Mrs. Anderson submitted was a mixture of hamburger, canned tomato soup, peas, Creamette brand elbow macaroni and celery. I would say this is more of a goulash but still qualifies as a hotdish.

The hotdish has evolved into many different versions. We have Italian, chicken, rice and even Spam hotdish. Our family favorite happens to be the tater tot hotdish. This savory beef and vegetable dish is held together with a binding agent, cream of mushroom soup. Top this baby off with tater tots and you'll have one happy tummy. Some chefs sprinkle cheese on top of their tots, scandalous! Not for this girl, the original dish will do. Simply delicious! Now if you really want to be adventurous, whip up some lime Jello with pears and you'll have quite the feast. Church basement style.
