\* Baltimore Orioles shortstop Cal Ripken, Jr. didn't miss a game in 16 years. He played in 2,632 consecutive games from April 30, 1982 to September 19, 1998.

\* Philadelphia A's (now the Oakland Athletics) manager Connie Mack has 3,755 career victories, more than any other manager in history.

\* The average life span of a major league baseball is 5-7 pitches.

\* There are 158 species of fish in Minnesota's 5,493 fishable lakes.

\* The panfish is the most popular fish caught in MN, followed by the walleye and northern.

\* The largest walleye caught in MN was 17.8 lbs and 35.8 inches long.
